Jeremy Malone is a Boise native having attended Boise schools and Boise State University studying Business Administration. Additionally, Mr. Malone attained his Real Property Administrator (RPA) designation from Building Owners & Managers Institute (BOMI) International as well as receiving his Construction Management Certificate from Boise State University. He has been with Oppenheimer Development Corporation since 1991 serving in various capacities from Administrative Assistant to Director of Property Management to his current role as Vice President.

Mr. Malone's responsibilities include overseeing new development projects and opportunities, the day-to-day management, maintenance, financial reporting, and over-sight of the Oppenheimer Development Corporation property portfolio.
